

## 2026 Course Fees - CPC30620 Certificate III in Painting

**Census / Withdrawal Date:** Each unit that you study has its own Census Date. It's important to know your Census Date. This is the deadline you can withdraw from your enrolment and still obtain a refund. The date is calculated at no less than 20% of the way through the period during which that unit is undertaken.

The Student tuition fees are indicative only and are subject to change given individual circumstances at enrolment. Additional fees may apply such as resource fees and other fees.

The maximum course fee for non-concession students undertaking a targeted fee relief course in 2026 is \$1,200. For concession students and youth, the maximum course fee for undertaking a targeted fee relief course in 2026 is \$400. These maximums apply per course in 2026. Where a student is transferred to an updated version of a course, the maximum will be applied as if the enrolment continues in a single course.
